According to credible military leaders, analysts and policy makers, assassination by drone violates international and U.S. law. The U.S. has used drones to kill thousands of people in Afghanistan, Iraq, Pakistan, Yemen, and Somalia. Many hundreds of the dead were civilians.

Drones used for domestic surveillance of U.S. citizens and residents potentially threaten our rights to privacy and to constitutionally-guaranteed rights to equal protection, due process, freedom of association and assembly, and protection from unreasonable search and seizure.
