How to Rewind the Doomsday Clock! The Bulletin of Atomic Scientists, which moved its Doomsday Clock ahead to just two minutes to midnight (Doomsday), offers these steps to rewind the clock: cool Trump rhetoric, negotiate with North Korea, stick with the Iran Deal, reduce U.S.-Russian tensions, and insist on global action on climate change. (#Rewindthenuclearclock)

In Minnesota, the WAMM Campaign to Ban Nuclear Weapons has collected 10,000 signatures on a petition to demand that the U.S. sign the legally binding international treaty on the prohibition of nuclear weapons. Also: Of the 123 nations that agreed to negotiate the treaty, as of mid-February, 56 nations have signed it and five have actually ratified it: Cuba, Guyana, the Holy See (the Vatican), Mexico, and Guyana. More are expected.
